SPECIES		<b>D.01 <i>Dendrobium alexanderae</i></b> Latouria section; flowers somewhat similar to Dendrobium spectabile, but the plant does not grow quite as tall	<b>\$38.00</b>
		<b>D.02 <i>Dendrobium amethystoglossa</i></b> ? Section (possibly Calista?); no fertilizer, and somewhat reduced watering in the winter months. Should be kept moist and fertilized regularly the rest of the year.	<b>\$35.00</b>
		<b>D.03 <i>Dendrobium bigibbum</i> (aka <i>Phalaenopsis</i>)</b> This population is producing pale pink flowers (whitish w pink center), and they are blooming on short canes (2-4"). BS	<b>\$32.00</b>
		<b>D.03 <i>Dendrobium chrysopterum</i></b> Few cultural instructions available. I suggest limited fertilizer and somewhat reduced watering in the winter months, do not let it dry out the rest of the year.	<b>\$36.00</b>
		<b>D.04 <i>Dendrobium finisterrae</i></b> No complete rest period; slightly reduced watering and little fertilizer during the winter months	<b>\$36.00</b>
		<b>D.05 <i>Dendrobium glomeratum</i></b>	
		<b>D.06 <i>Dendrobium lindleyi</i> (aka <i>aggregatum</i>)</b> Plenty of water & regular fertilizer during spring & summer. September 15th: Stop fertilizing. October 15th: Reduce watering 90% (once every 3-4 weeks) Place plant cool & bright. Once buds form, resume normal watering. Once flowers open, resume normal fertilizing.	BS plant  <b>\$36.00</b>

<b>S P E C I E S</b>		<b>D.07 <i>Dendrobium nobile</i>, var. <i>album</i></b> Plenty of water & regular fertilizer during spring & summer. September 15th: Stop fertilizing. October 15th: Reduce watering 90% (once every 3-4 weeks) Place plant cool & bright. Once buds form, resume normal watering. Once flowers open, resume normal fertilizing.	1 yr to BS	<b>\$20.00</b>
		<b>D.08 <i>Dendrobium sanderae</i></b> No complete rest period; slightly reduced watering and little fertilizer during the winter months. Young plants, 1-2 years to BS		<b>\$28.00</b>
<b>H Y B R I D S</b>		<b>D.11 Den. Alice Iwanaga</b> (Thomas Warne x <i>sanderae</i> ), plants grow 18-24" tall, and produce very large and long lasting white flowers. No real rest period, less fertilizer & slightly reduced watering in winter months. BS		<b>\$48.00</b>
		<b>D.11 Den., unregistered hybrid</b> (Sunny Vista x Dunokayla '808 Orchids'), a yellow 'Aussie' Dendrobium, which takes after speciosum. Young plants require no rest, but once BS it should be treated identical to that of Den. kingianum.	2 yr to BS	<b>\$32.00</b>

		<b>D.12 Den. Peng Seng</b> ( <i>cruentum</i> x <i>tobaense</i> ), a compact plant with long lasting flowers. Culture similar to above. BS		<b>\$42.00</b>
		<b>D.13 Den. QF Makani</b> (Dawn Maree x Peng Seng), a mid size plant with long lasting flowers. Since seed grown, the amount of orange on the lip varies. Culture similar to above. BS		<b>\$45.00</b>
		<b>D.14 Den. Victorian Jazz '808 Orchids'</b> Meristem, a strongly colored 'Aussie' Dendrobium. Just potted up into 3" pots. 1-2 years to blooming size. Culture identical to that of Den. kingianum.		<b>\$28.00</b>
