



		<b>C.34 <i>Rby.</i> TLDC Divine Phoenix 'Pterodactyl' SM/WOC21</b> ( <i>Brassavola appendiculata</i> x <i>Rlc.</i> Bryce Canyon), this spectacular hybrid received the equivalent of an AM at the WOC21. Flowers are about 5" across, and the color is intense	<b>\$42.00</b>

		<b>C.37 <i>Cahuzacara</i> **, unregistered hybrid</b> ( <i>Chz.</i> Hsinying Pink Doll x <i>Ctt.</i> Bactia 'Grape Wax'), a speculative cross between a traditional corsage type, and a bifoliate that can produce 25+ flowers on a mature plant. These are young plants, at least 3 years to BS	<b>\$24.00</b>
		<b>C.38 <i>Rlc.</i>, unregistered hybrid</b> (Secret Affair 'Thanksgiving' x Ellen Degeneres 'Ghosts + Goblins'), large orange x large pink should produce art shade flowers. Seedlings, 2-3 years to BS	<b>\$32.00</b>
