


H Y B R I D S	I could not locate any photos of this new Grex	H.01 <i>Paph</i> Helen's Cutie (<i>Little Davey</i> x <i>Wössner Helene</i>) , making this a mini complex. The primary genetic contributions are: <i>charlesworthii</i> 31.3%, <i>helenae</i> 31.3%, <i>henryanum</i> 12.5% & <i>insigne</i> 9.4%. Young seedlings, approx. 4" leaf span.	\$36.00
		H.02 <i>Paph.</i> Little Trouble (<i>barbigerum</i> x <i>charlesworthii</i>) , this primary hybrid is a tiny plant (4-5" leaf span). It was made with album forms, but since these species carry the mutation on different genes, these plants have colored flowers. They carry the recessive genes, so they could breed albums in the next generation.	\$30.00
	I have not been able to find any photos of this newer hybrid	H.03 <i>Paph</i> QF Ha'aheo (<i>barbatum</i> x <i>leucochilum</i>) , this primary hybrid can produce some stunning flowers, photo shown is from a plant of this population. NBS/BS seedlings	\$35.00

	I have not been able to find any photos of this newer hybrid	H.05 <i>Paph</i> QF Wild Man (<i>[bellatulum</i> x <i>hangianum</i>] x <i>malipoense</i>) , this is a very interesting combination. Good size seedlings, but probably still about 2 years to BS (both <i>hangianum</i> & <i>malipoense</i> grow fairly large)	\$55.00
		H.06 <i>Paph</i> Snow Squall (<i>Greyi</i> x <i>delenatii</i>) , this combination can produce flowers that are either all white, or with some stippling.	\$55.00
	I have not been able to find any photos of this 130 year old hybrid	H.07 <i>Paph.</i> Spicero-Niveum (<i>niveum</i> x <i>spicerianum</i>) , this primary hybrid was registered in 1893, yet I can find no photos anywhere. Seedlings are smallish in 2" pots, 1-2 years to BS	\$35.00

H Y B R I D S		H.08 <i>Paph. Vexillarium</i> <i>(barbatum x fairrieianum)</i> , this population has produced consistently very good quality flowers (photo = 83 pt AM/AOS). Plants stay compact and grow fast; seedlings are NBS/BS	\$35.00
		H.09 <i>Paph. White Madonna</i> <i>(niveum x acmodontum)</i> , another combination that can produce some absolutely stunners. These plants are available both NBS & BS	2¼" pot \$35.00 3½" pot \$48.00

		M.02 <i>Paph. Iantha Stage</i> <i>(rothschildianum x sukhakulii)</i> , this multifloral (usually 2 flowers) will start blooming from a single mature growth. BS seedlings	\$65
		M.03 <i>Paph. Julius</i> <i>(lowii x rothschildianum)</i> , a remake of the classic from 1914. These are large seedlings, about 1 year to BS	\$110
		M.04 <i>Paph. Lady Isabel</i> (aka Lady Isobel) <i>(rothschildianum x stonei)</i> , another classic multi-floral, first registered in 1897	\$95
		M.05 <i>Paph. Memoria Albert Eickhoff</i> <i>(kolopakingii x stonei)</i> , these are large plants, but with a potential for a high flower count. Single growth, BS	\$135

M U L T I F L O R A L S		M.06 <i>Paph. QF Yellow Bird</i> (<i>Toni Semple x lowii</i> , fma. <i>album</i>), these are BS plants in 4" pots, most have 1.1/2 growths. I have one with bud, it looks like it is producing 5 or 6 flowers.	\$85
		M.07 <i>Paph. Rolfei</i> (<i>bellatulum x rothschildianum</i>), when produced with wild collected roths, these were impossible to bloom. Now that line bred roths are used, they will bloom	\$95
		M.08 <i>Paph. Toni Semple</i> (<i>haynaldianum x lowii</i>), a moderately sized plant; BS in 4" pots	\$85
		M.09 <i>Paph. Wössner Vietnam Star</i> (<i>rothschildianum x vietnamense</i>), some of these have budded up as single growth plants, compact for a multi-floral	BS \$75 in Bud \$85
		M.10 unnamed Grex (<i>Greyi x kolopakingii</i>), the brachy parent helps keep the plant size moderate. BS, most plants are multi-growth	\$68

P H R A G S		P.01 <i>Phragmipedium Faust's Panache</i> (<i>Sorcerer's Apprentice x exstaminodium</i>), this is a 'different' long-petalled hybrid. Plants are NBS/BS	\$66
		P.02 <i>Phragmipedium Mont Fallu</i> (<i>longifolium</i> , var. <i>roezlii</i> x Grande 'PR'), this is one of the true long-petalled hybrids. I have 3 plants available, and all are in bud	\$68
